

REVISED POLICY

1 | APPOINTMENT, ASSIGNMENTSASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER, AND
2 | PROMOTION OF STAFF

3 Competent and qualified employees are essential to the successful functioning of the
4 District.

5 The Superintendent shall appoint, assign, transfer, and promote staff. The
6 Superintendent shall also ~~and~~ communicate the duties, days, and hours of the
7 various classifications of employees.

8 A. Employees shall perform the duties required by Florida
9 ~~statutes~~laws, Board policy, District administrative procedures, and
10 all other duties as assigned. Failure to perform such duties in an
11 acceptable manner shall constitute a violation of an administrator's
12 contract and become just cause for disciplinary action.

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15 B. Employees are responsible for ~~student control and maintaining a~~
16 safe environment, which includes continual supervision and
17 oversight of students, including supervision and oversight of
18 volunteers working with students, at any location on campus or
19 during school-sponsored and after school activities.

20 C. Employees shall not permit their family members or friends by their
21 presence to interfere with performance of their duties during
22 working hours.

23 The Superintendent shall appoint, assign, transfer, and promote employees
24 pursuant to statutory requirements.

25 Such assignments shall be consistent with the collective bargaining agreement if
26 applicable.
