

REVISED POLICY

APPOINTMENT, ASSIGNMENTS, ASSIGNMENT, TRANSFER, AND PROMOTION
OF STAFF

Competent and qualified employees are essential to the successful functioning of the District.

The Superintendent shall appoint, assign, transfer, and promote staff. ~~The Superintendent shall also~~ ~~and~~ communicate the duties, days, and hours of the various classifications of employees.

A. Employees shall perform the duties required by Florida ~~statutes,~~ laws, Board policy, District administrative procedures, the collective bargaining agreement, and all other duties as assigned. Failure to perform such duties in an acceptable manner shall constitute a violation of the employee's contract and become just cause for disciplinary action.

B. Employees are responsible for maintaining a safe environment, student control and ~~which includes continual~~ supervision and oversight of students, including supervision and oversight of volunteers working with students, at any location on campus or during school-sponsored and after school activities.

C. Employees shall not permit their family members or friends by their presence to interfere with performance of their duties during working hours.

The Superintendent shall appoint, assign, transfer and promote employees pursuant to statutory requirements.

Such assignments shall be consistent with the collective bargaining agreement if applicable.
