Locally, a small group of concerned parents who wanted their kids to have fun, celebrate and be safe started the very first Project Graduation in Collier County over twenty-six years ago. Since the event's inception, the YMCA has been the host venue and lead partner in bringing together hundreds of dedicated Volunteers and local businesses. Project Graduation has grown and is host to more than 1,200 graduates from twelve Collier County Schools.

On Friday, June 1, we will celebrate the 27th Anniversary of YMCA Project Graduation. Collier County's Project Graduation is one of the nation's longest running, drug and alcohol-free celebrations. Graduation night can be a deadly and dangerous night. **Since YMCA Project Graduation's inception in 1985, there has never been an alcohol related fatality on Graduation night in Collier County.**
