Positive Behavior Support (PBS)



What is Positive Behavior Support (PBS)?

- PBS aims to build effective environments in which positive behavior is more effective than problem behavior.
- PBS is a collaborative assessment-based approach to developing effective interventions for problem behavior.
- PBS emphasizes the use of preventative teaching and re-inforcement-based strategies to achieve meaningful and durable behavior and life-style outcomes.
